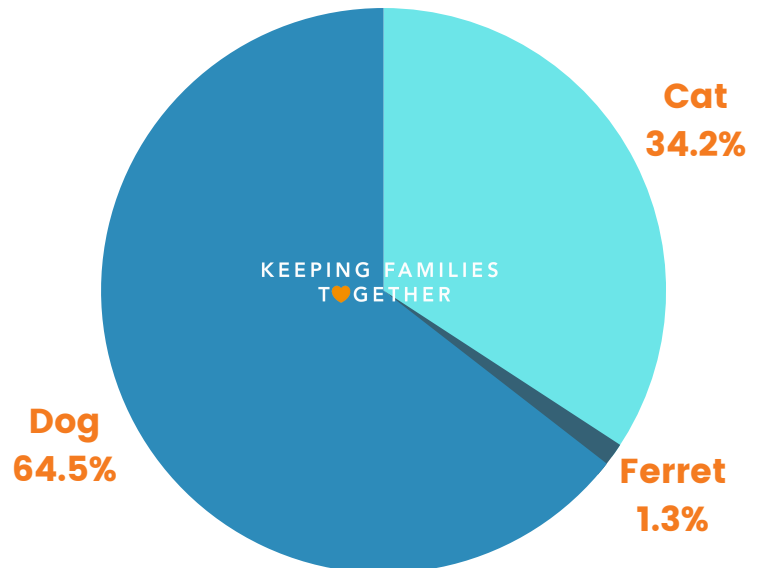
76 pets saved
